First Aid Equipment Statement

Clydesdale Cricket Club

Clydesdale Cricket Club has first aid equipment/supplies required in place, and these are available for use at all coaching sessions, competitions and festivals.

These include;

- One guidance card and contents card
- Individually wrapped sterile and waterproof, adhesive dressings (assorted sizes), appropriate to the club environment
- Sterile eye pads, with attachment
- Six individually wrapped triangular bandages
- Safety pins
- Medium and large sized, individually wrapped, sterile unmedicated wound dressings
- Antiseptic tissues, sterile water or saline in sealed disposable containers
- If emergency blankets are provided, they should be stored alongside equipment, and in such a way as to keep them free from dust and damp
- Disposable aprons and plastic gloves should be provided near the first aid materials
- Blunt ended scissors should be kept where there is a possibility that clothing or material needs to be cut
- Plastic disposable bags for soiled or used first-aid dressings should be provided
- In addition, it may be necessary to purchase sports specific first aid equipment depending on the nature of the activity e.g. stretcher etc.

The First Aid equipment shall be located In the Kitchen in the Main Club House and in the Coaches' Office in the Junior Pavilion. Clydesdale Cricket club will ensure that all relevant club personnel are aware of the location of this equipment.
